








Map Areas

Fares and Ticket Information

Operators offer many ticket options to suit your travel needs. These range from single, return, and day tickets to weekly, monthly and annual tickets. There are tickets for students and young people, group tickets, and ticket bundles for hybrid workers.

Ways to buy tickets:

- on operators' phone apps
- on the bus using contactless payment or cash except metrobus which is a buy before you board and Tap on, Tap off service
- online where you can top up your Travelwest travelcard
- from iPoints at metrobus stops at bus and train stations

Multi-operator tickets:

Rider tickets are day tickets accepted by most bus operators in a given area. Valid for travel on the day of issue up to 0259 the following morning. Take as many journeys as you like during that time. Weekly tickets available.

AvonRider: West of England and North Somerset.

WestonRider: encompassing Weston urban area, extending north to the River Yeo, east to the M5, and south to the river Axe. See main map for area covered Visit travelwest.info/Rider

PlusBus is an add-on to a train ticket giving unlimited local bus travel (on participating bus operators' services) around the whole of the urban area.

Freedom Travelpass gives unlimited train and bus travel within four zones in the region for the day, week or month.

Concessionary Travel

If you have an English concessionary bus pass, vou can travel for free on most local buses in the West of England region at the following times:

- **Mondays to Fridays:** Any time except in the morning between 0400 and 0900.
- Weekends and Public Holidays: Any time.

Please note that time restrictions vary elsewhere in England so please check with the relevant council.

If you live in the West of England, you can apply for a Diamond Travelcard bus pass from your council.

Community Transport

There are a wide range of community transport services available across the region. Operators provide essential transport within the community and are particularly well-placed to cater for passengers with limited mobility

- Flexible door-to-door transport On-demand services for scheme members, covering essential everyday travel, including medical appointments, visiting friends, regular trips, supermarket visits and days out.
- Scheduled door-to-door transport Regular scheduled journeys in fully accessible vehicles, catering for shopping trips, doctor's appointments, and other destinations.
- **Volunteer car schemes** Volunteer drivers offering transport providing essential trips to medical appointments, including hospital trips. There is usually a request for a donation to cover travel expenses.
- Transport for community groups Accessible vehicles owned by community groups are made available to other organisations for low-cost hire. Perfect for youth groups, lunch clubs and any organisation that needs one-off or regular travel for events and meetings.
- **Outings and day trips** Some community transport schemes run trips and excursions throughout the year to places of interest within their area and further afield.

Weston's Coastal Routes

Cruise along the coast between Weston-super-Mare and Sand Bay on service 1, Weston's Coaster. Enjoy the journey from the top deck, often opentopped in the summer. With handy pick-up from the rail station and the bus interchange (Bay J), there are frequent stops along the way including the Grand Pier, the Winter Gardens, Knightstone Harbour, Prince Consort Gardens, and Kewstoke. Purchase a West of England Day ticket and hop on and off as much as you like.



Or take a trip on service 20 from Weston-super-Mare interchange (Bay B) to Burnham-on-Sea.

Travelling to and from Bristol Airport by bus is easy and convenient, with direct links to Bristol, Bath, Weston-super-Mare and the South West. Regular services run throughout the day and night, and buses stop right outside the terminal.

A1 Bristol Airport Flyer – Bristol Bus Station to Bristol Airport. Journey time approximately 45 minutes during the day.

A3 Weston Airport Flyer - Weston-super-Mare to Bristol Airport via Worle, Congresbury and Cleeve. Journey time approximately 43 minutes.


A4 Air Decker – Bath to Bristol Airport. Journey time approximately 1 hour 20 minutes during the day.

Located off the A370 in Long Ashton BS3 2HB. Take the **metrobus m2** to central Bristol. Operates Monday to Saturday. **505** to Southmead Hospital via Clifton (departs Bower Ashton on Sundays).

Portway Park & Ride

Located on the A4 in Shirehampton BS11 9QE. Take bus service 9. or train in to Bristol.
