



Park & Ride Services for Bristol

Whether you are commuting, shopping, or visiting, park your car and ride in comfort to your destination.



Park & Ride sites north of Bristol centre:

Lyde Green Park & Ride

Located off the Rosary roundabout A4174 on Willowherb Road BS16 7LX.

Take the **metrobus m3 / m3x** to central Bristol. Journey time ≈ 35 / 28 minutes. Services **86** and **462** also call here.

Parkway North Park & Ride

Located immediately east of Parkway Station on Hunts Ground, Stoke Gifford BS34 8PU. Take the metrobus m4 to central Bristol or Cribbs

serving the transport hub.

Located on the A4 in Shirehampton BS11 9QE.

Community Transport

There are a wide range of community transport services available across the region. Operators provide essential transport within the community and are particularly well-placed to cater for passengers with limited mobility.

- Flexible door-to-door transport On-demand services for scheme members, covering essential everyday travel, including medical appointments, visiting friends, regular trips, supermarket visits and days out.
- Scheduled door-to-door transport Regular scheduled journeys in fully accessible vehicles, catering for shopping trips, doctor's appointments, and other destinations.
- Volunteer car schemes Volunteer drivers offering transport providing essential trips to medical appointments, including hospital trips. There is usually a request for a donation to cover travel expenses.
- Transport for community groups Accessible vehicles owned by community groups are made available to other organisations for low-cost hire. Perfect for youth groups, lunch clubs and any organisation that needs one-off or regular travel for events and meetings.
- Outings and day trips Some community transport schemes run trips and excursions throughout the year to places of interest within their area and further afield.


