Payments are capped so you'll never pay more than the zone's day ticket fare for each day you travel. VISA, Mastercard, **Bath & North East Somerset Council** Apple Pay and Google Pay are accepted.

Cost saver tickets Rider tickets are day tickets that are accepted by participating bus operators in a given area. Starting at just £5 per ticket, they give unlimited

This is one in a series of four guides which transport in the West of England region. The Combined Authority comprises the constituent local councils of Bath & North East Somerset, Road Main Road Batch **WESTlink** is a different type of bus service which operates in the vast majority of the West of England, outside of Bristol and Bath city centres. It runs without a fixed timetable or route, and can be booked by people through the **WESTlink** app or Passengers can get on or off at existing bus stops (over 1,800), a number of "virtual stops", as well as at a number of easy to reach places. If you want to travel further, you can connect to major bus and Single fares are available at £2 for adults and £1 for children.
