- · All are low-floored and wheelchair accessible.


Parkway North, Portway, and Yate Park & Ride sites are close to railway stations where you can continue your journey by train.

- · Located to the east of Parkway rail station on Hunts Ground, Stoke Gifford BS34 8PU.
- The station is a 6-minute walk (450 metres).
- Parking is limited to 18 hours.
- There is a parking charge at Parkway North payable via the MiPermit app, location number 705301.

Yate

- Located on the A432 Badminton Road BS37 5AF. Parking is free and available 24 hours a day,
- 7 days a week.
- EV charging points are available.

Rider tickets are multi-operator tickets that give you virtually unlimited travel on buses in defined zones. The Avon Rider zone covers Bath & North East Somerset, Bristol, North Somerset, and South Gloucestershire.

The Bristol Rider zone is approximately within a 6-mile radius of Bristol centre.




