Fares and tickets

Buses

Most bus fares start at £2.50 for singles and £7 for a day ticket.

Ways to buy

- Operators' phone apps
- Contactless or cash on the bus (except metrobus services)
- iPoints at metrobus stops
- For metrobus services you must buy before you board or use Tap On, Tap Off*

*On Bath Bus Company, Faresaver and First Bus services (including metrobus) tap the same card/device when getting on and off the bus for automatic fare calculation.

Rail fares

From £3.80 for singles and £3.90 for returns from Yate railway station. Tickets can be bought at ticket offices, machines at stations or online.

Cost saver tickets

- Multi-operator bus tickets are available. An AvonRider ticket, which covers the whole region is just £7 and allows unlimited travel for a day on almost all buses in the area. Find out more at travelWEST.info/Rider
- Freedom Travelpass is a flexible ticket for unlimited train and bus travel on participating services. Day tickets start at just £14.50 in this area. travelWEST.info/FreedomTravelpass

41	Yate to Malmesbury, via Chipping Sodbury and Acton Turville. 4 journeys a day Monday to Friday, from around 10:50 to 17:10, with Saturday services also available. Coachstyle service.			
86	Kingswood to Yate Shopping Centre, via Emersons Green, Lyde Green and Coalpit Heath. Buses run every hour on weekdays from around 07:40 to 19:50, with Saturday services also available. Stagecoach service.			
525	Emersons Green to Yate, via Pucklechurch and Westerleigh. Buses run every hour on weekdays from around 06:00 to 20:30, with weekend services also available. Stagecoach service.			
620	Bath to Old Sodbury, via Wick, Pucklechurch, Yate and Chipping Sodbury. Service also links to Stroud. 6 journeys Monday to Friday, from around 06:15 to 18:50. 4 journeys on Saturday. Stagecoach service.			
Y2C	Cribbs Causeway to Yate via Rangeworthy, Thornbury, Alveston, Tockington and Almondsbury. Buses run approximately every 90 mins from 06:00 to 20:00, Monday to Saturday. VIA service.			
Y1	Bristol city centre to Abbotswood (Yate), via Winterbourne and Frampton Cotterell. Buses run every 30 minutes on weekdays from around 05:00 to 00:30, with weekend services also available. First Bus service.			
Y2	Bristol city centre to Ladden Garden Village (Yate), via Winterbourne and Frampton Cotterell. Buses run every 30 minutes on weekdays from around 05:50 to 23:40, with weekend services also available. First Bus service.			
Y6	Bristol to Chipping Sodbury via Southmead Hospital and Cribbs Causeway. Buses run every 90 minutes on weekdays from around 06:00 to 22:30, with weekend services also available. First Bus service.			
Y8	Yate to Wotton-under-Edge via Chipping Sodbury, Hawkesbury Upton, Charfield and Wickwar. 4 Journeys a day, Monday to Saturday, from around 08:00 to 17:00. The Big Lemon service.			
₹	Yate Railway Station. Regular services to Bristol Temple Meads .

WESTlink

WESTlink is a bookable service without a fixed timetable or route which can be done via app or telephone on 0117 457 8561. Ideal for local journeys and to connect with buses and trains, it runs in the majority of the West of England, outside of Bristol and Bath city centres.

From Yate, Chipping Sodbury or surrounding areas, it is possible to travel as far as Southmead Hospital, UWE and Wotton-underedge. You can also travel to Thornbury if starting your journey from Yate or Chipping Sodbury town centres.





Concessionary Travelcard

Disabled and older person's travelcards may be available to you if you're of pensionable age, or have a qualifying disability. With these travelcards you're entitled to free travel on buses Monday to Friday (older person's off-peak only) and anytime weekends and public holidays. To check if you're eligible and find out how to apply visit travelWEST.info/ConcessionaryCard

Community Transport

Community transport is available to all residents across the West of England and is a service particularly well placed to cater for passengers with limited mobility. Operators offer a range of services such as door-to-door transport for essential travel and outings and day trips to places of interest within your area or further afield. Travel to Bristol Airport

A frequent bus service runs from Bristol bus station, via the city centre and Temple Meads railway station, to Bristol Airport, day and night. Visit **travelWEST.info/Airport** or **bristolairport.co.uk** for details.

WESTscoot & WESTbike

Hop on and enjoy a safe and easy way to get around Bath, Bristol and South Gloucestershire. Hiring an e-scooter or e-bike is a great way to travel to work, the shops, or simply explore your local area.

Yate Park & Ride

You can park your car and ride public transport in comfort from Yate Park & Ride to Southmead Hospital and Bristol City Centre.

Located on the A432 Badminton Road BS37 5AF. Parking is free and available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There's a height restriction of 7'6" / 2.3m.
