## Fares and tickets

### Buses

Most bus fares start at £2.60 for singles and £6.80 for a day ticket.

### Ways to buy

- Operators' phone apps
- Contactless or cash on the bus (except metrobus services)
- iPoints at metrobus stops
- For metrobus services you must buy before you board or use Tap On, Tap Off\*

\*On Faresaver and First Bus services (including metrobus) tap the same card/device when getting on and off the bus for automatic fare calculation.

### Rail fares

From £5.10 for singles and £5.20 for returns from Keynsham station to Bristol Temple Meads or Bath Spa. Tickets can be bought at ticket offices, machines at stations or online. Find the best fare for your journey at [nationalrail.co.uk](https://www.nationalrail.co.uk).

### Cost saver tickets

- Multi-operator bus tickets are available. A BristolRider ticket, which covers a wider Bristol area, including Keynsham, is just £6.50 and allows unlimited travel for a day on almost all buses in the area. Find out more at [travelWEST.info/Rider](https://travelWEST.info/Rider)

## Concessionary Travelcard

Disabled and older person's travelcards may be available to you if you're of pensionable age, or have a qualifying disability.

With these travelcards you're entitled to free travel on buses Monday to Friday (Older persons from 9am) and anytime weekends and public holidays.

## WESTlink

**WESTlink** is a bookable service without a fixed timetable or route which can be booked via app or telephone on 0117 457 8561. Ideal for local journeys and to connect with buses and trains, it runs in the majority of the West of England, outside of Bristol and Bath city centres.

The service runs Monday to Saturday, 7am to 7pm.

Journeys are available across the West of England zone and the Airport shared zone, up to a maximum of 8 miles.

You can travel longer distances with a **WESTlink** – simply connect with standard buses or trains.

Older person's bus passes will be accepted from 9am.

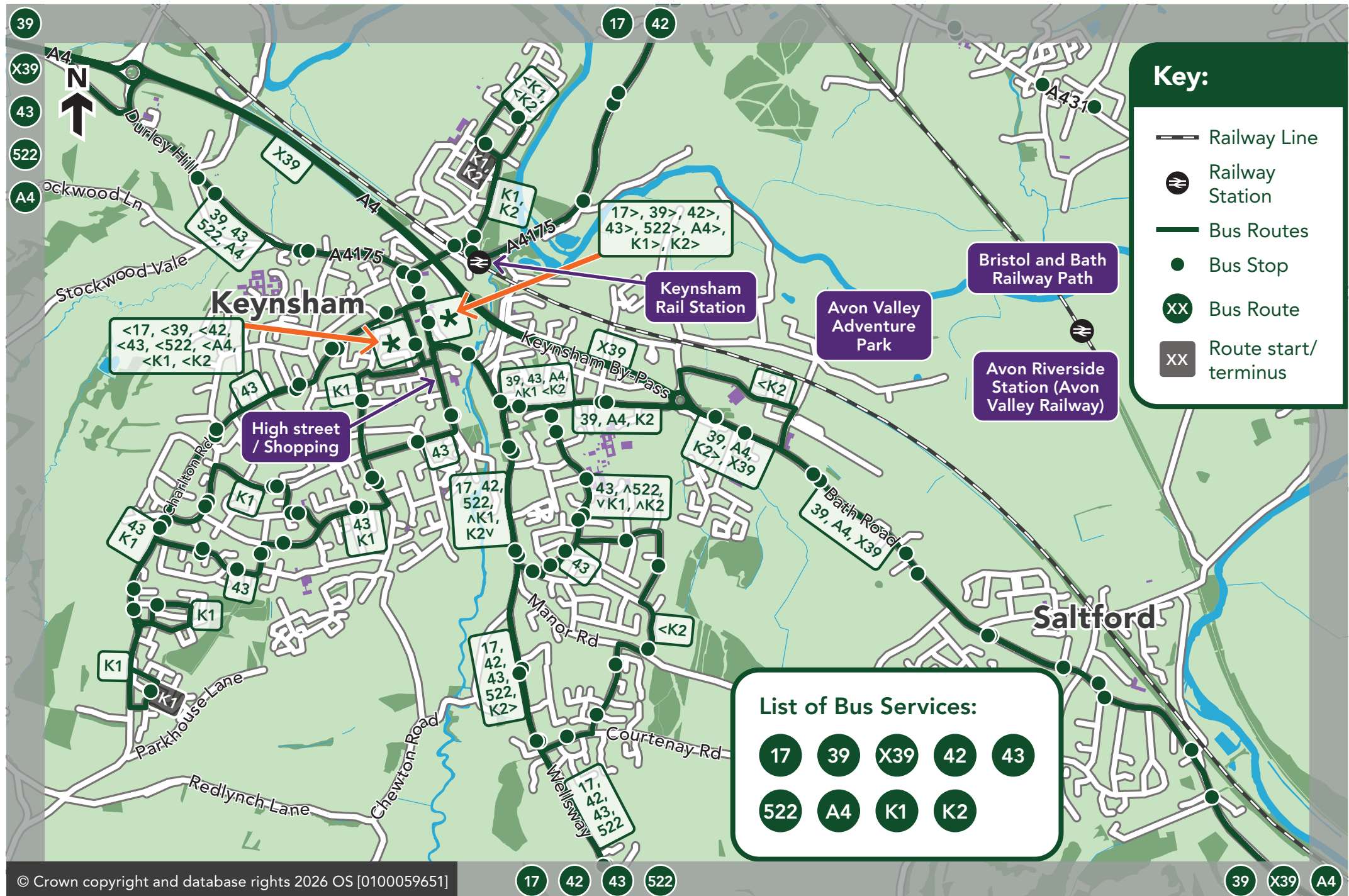

Please make sure your concessionary pass is registered on your account either on the app or on the phone, before you book a journey.

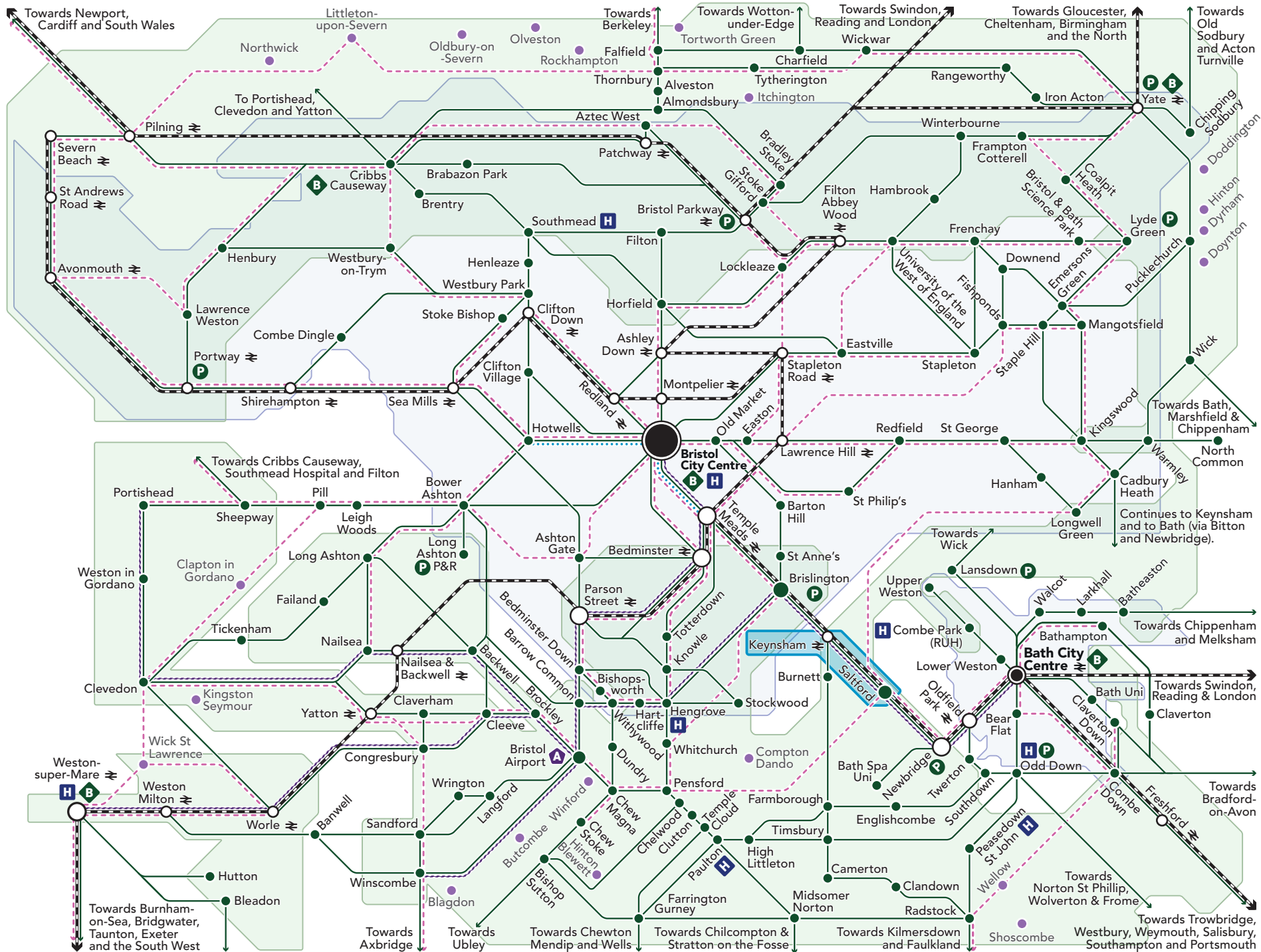

## Park & Ride

Park and ride in comfort from convenient sites to Bath and Bristol city centres, with free all-day parking at most locations when using public transport. Keynsham and Saltford travellers can use Brislington Park & Ride for Bristol and Newbridge Park & Ride for Bath. Long Ashton serves Southmead Hospital, while Odd Down serves the Royal United Hospital.

### Bristol

Parking is free for public transport users. All sites have a height restriction of 6'10" / 2.1m.

- **Brislington Park & Ride:** Located on the A4 in Brislington, BS4 5LR. Open Monday to Saturday 05:15 to 00:30 and Sunday & Public Holidays 08:30 to 19:30.
- **Long Ashton Park & Ride:** Located off the A370 in Long Ashton, BS3 2HB. Open Monday to Saturday 05:00 to 00:00 and Sunday & Public Holidays 07:00 to 20:00.

Operated by Bristol City Council Parking Services. For any site concerns, contact [parking.business@bristol.gov.uk](mailto:parking.business@bristol.gov.uk). The sites are locked overnight. Please call Parking Services on 0117 903 8070 if your vehicle is locked in.

### Bath

Open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. You must pay for parking if you're not using the bus or if you're parking overnight. Payment must be made via the MiPermit app.

- **Newbridge Park & Ride:** Located on the A4 west of Bath, BA1 3NB. Height restriction of 6'6" / 2m.
- **Odd Down Park & Ride:** Located on the A367 south of Bath, BA2 8PA. Height restriction of 7'2" / 2.2m.
